4. First-aid measures

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5. Fire-fighting measures

Special fire-fighting procedures: Use water spray to keep fire-exposed containers cool.

Special protective equipment for fire-fighters: Firefighters must wear NIOSH/MSHA approved positive pressure self-contained breathing apparatus with full face mask and full protective clothing.

6. Accidental release measures
